Sheriff Duff was appointed resident Sheriff of Tayside, Central and Fife based at Dundee in July 2004. Between 1993-2004 he was a Solicitor Advocate with criminal rights of audience. Prior to that, Sheriff Duff was a Solicitor in private practice from admission in 1977 and a Procurator Fiscal Depute from 1977-1981. Sheriff Duff is a former member of the Law Society of Council, the McInnes Committee on Summary Justice Reform, and the McLeish Committee on the use of imprisonment. He was appointed Deputy Director of the Judicial Studies Committee (now the Judicial Institute) in September 2011.
